

OPEN THE BOOK



If you have children or grandchildren at Boxted School you may have heard them talking about Open the Book and wondered what it's all about. Children's explanations can be somewhat confusing so you might have been told things like, "It's a group of old people," "We get to dress up," or "We have time to think about it afterwards" all of which are true but that's not the whole picture.

Open the Book is a national project which is run by the Bible Society and gives children the opportunity to hear Bible stories dramatised by a team of local Christians during school assemblies. Most of these stories are taken from the Lion Storyteller Bible by Bob Hartman. We also use an Open the Book handbook which provides an introduction, a reflection and a prayer to accompany each story.

The team usually go into Boxted School, twice each team, and have been doing so for the past five and a half years. There are currently seven of us on the team. We are all retired but would happily welcome younger members! No great acting ability is required - just a desire to share these wonderful stories with the next generation.

In addition, the local church runs the Zone, a youth club for primary age children, which meets in Boxted Methodist Church Hall on Friday evenings. Further details from **Dominic Sheil** on **01206 273324.**
