## **BOXTED PARISH COUNCIL**



**BOXTED** COMMUNITY **HUB** 

Boxted Community Hub has proved to be a huge success since its opening in the summer last year, but it is becoming apparent that the many years of neglect prior to the Council taking control have left the building in poor repair and Boxted Parish Council, as owners of the building, now have to start looking at more major repairs if the Hub is going to be able to continue. The most pressing issue at present is the roof which needs replacing at a cost of around £20,000.

The Council are seeking grant funding to cover this but if this is not successful they will be seeking a loan from the Public Works Loan Board, with the intention of the repayments being covered from the income generated by the Hub.

In a worst case scenario increases to local council tax may be necessary to cover the capital and interest, although this is something the Council will be working hard to avoid. The Council will be looking carefully at this idea at meetings in the coming months, all of which are open to the public.

Meetings are held on the second Wednesday of each month commencing at 7pm at Boxted Village Hall.
