Spotlight on....

“BLUE PLANET BOXTED”

In the BBC's Blue Planet, David Attenborough warned us that litter does not simply disfigure our environment but is seriously damaging. Boxted's volunteer litter pickers have appreciated this for some time and 2018 marks the Group's tenth anniversary.

More than twenty volunteers have for the last ten years given up an hour of their time each month to pick up litter alongside Boxted's roads. The village may not yet be litter free but it is so very much better than it was ten years ago. We salute the efforts of each and every one of these volunteers.

Many of the volunteers have been involved from the beginning. However some have inevitably moved on and others are ready to pass on their litter pickers to the next generation!

At the moment 85% of Boxted's roads are litter picked. However we need about six new volunteers so that we can, not simply maintain the Group's numbers, but also extend litter picking to 100% of Boxted's roads.

Are you willing to be such a volunteer? Existing volunteers aim to walk their designated stretch of road once a month although this may not always be possible. We can provide each volunteer with a good quality litter picker and also arrange for an existing volunteer to show new comers the ropes including advising on safety.

Happy New Year from everyone at Open Door Café!

We meet every Friday during term time, from 8.45am to 10.15am, in Boxted Village Hall. Most of our visitors are young mums with children who enjoy a time to chat while the children have the opportunity to play and socialise.

BOXTED HISTORY GROUP

At November's talk, entitled 'A Few Tales and Songs of the Country', Neil Catchpole recalled his life working on a farm from the age of 14 through to Country Conservationist when he retired. Dressed in a 'Dandy' Suffolk suit with matching brown bowler hat (the Sunday dress of young aspiring farm workers from the mid 1860's to the 1950's), he supported his talk with a very large collection of farm and country artefacts.

Illness forced December's speaker to cancel but the day was saved at short notice by Chris Farndell. Using a large personal collection of cameras, related equipment and photographs Chris traced the history of photography from the pinhole camera up to the start of the digital age.

It was interesting to see how some very expensive cameras have been made virtually worthless by relatively cheap digital ones whilst some of the old 'Box and Bellows' type cameras which many of us discarded are now commanding 'big money'.

LANGHAM LADIES

Roger Newnham, J.P gave a fascinating insight into his work as a magistrate over the last 15 years.

The magistracy has come a long way since the first peace keepers were introduced in 1361, to a point where today there are more women than men working as magistrates.

There were some very amusing anecdotes of criminals trying to excuse their behaviour, sometimes incriminating themselves in the process and some very sad incidents of individuals being criminalised who really only needed help and compassion to get their lives back on track.

Our next meeting is an open meeting, on Thursday 8th February in the main hall at Langham Community Centre, at 8.00 p.m, when our speaker is Simon Gallup, who will give a talk and film about Flatford. Guests, male and female are very welcome to join us for a guest fee of £5.
