

RIVER STOUR TRUST

Saturday 12th May saw the official opening of the River Stour Trust's restored lock at Stratford St Mary by our Vice President Griff Rhys-Jones, Mark Harling of our major funder, Enovert, and Mrs Mary Harrison, the widow of Tony Harrison, whose legacy funded the new lock gates.

We were delighted to welcome guests including James Cartlidge MP and John Flack MEP, council representatives from Essex, Babergh, Colchester, Langham, Dedham and Stratford, and the Inland Waterways Association to join our members in celebration. Our guests were taken on the newly accessible stretch of river in our electric launches, joining the flotilla of private boats.

Apart from the lock gates which were made and installed by Hargreaves of Halifax, the restoration was done entirely by volunteers, who put in 15,000 man-hours of work on site over a period of 12 years.

In recognition of his work on the project, the RST have re-named the lock Roger Brown Lock. Roger lives in Boxted.


