PLANS FOR ARDLEIGH SURGERY

Due to changes in the way in which NHS contracts will in future be awarded to surgeries, Ardleigh Surgery is to join The Colte Partnership (TCP) from its launch on 1st June 2017.

This will be a partnership of 12 local practices and will cover 120,000 patients.

The move is expected to include the following benefits:

- Strength in numbers
- Sustainability
- Being able to bid for contracts and new services
- Freeing up more clinician time
- A bigger voice in the future of local healthcare
- Savings through reducing duplication and through centralised purchasing

As a patient, you may be concerned about what changes you will notice. The answer is simply you should not see any differences. You will still be registered at Ardleigh Surgery, and be seen here. Doctors and staff will remain working here and the surgery will retain autonomy to make decisions about how Ardleigh Surgery is run. It is hoped that as the Partnership establishes itself you will see additional services offered locally and improvements to community services.

SPOTLIGHT ON....

PATCHWORK PALS







An explosion of colour and a warm welcome greeted me at the Patchwork Pals session.

The colour was from the numerous quilts displayed around the walls of the Langham Community Centre, as it transpired that the patchworkers had decided it would be inspiring to have a look at what other members had produced.

The group was started 14 years ago by Pat Ward and Sue Kemp who had belonged to another such group, but decided to set up their own. Patchwork Pals is still going strong and, all these years later, still boasts four of the original members as well as many others.

Although the group is 40 strong, varying numbers attend each meeting, with members aged 30 - 80ish and come from as far afield as Ipswich, Felixstowe and Harwich to join in the session. In fact, only five members come from Langham, so some local additions would be welcome.

As well as working on their individual projects, members of the group also make quilts for the neo-natal unit at Colchester Hospital where they are used in the incubators to nurture the new-borns. No-one is absolutely sure how many quilts they have made for the unit so far, but it's probably in excess of 300, with the latest batch of 64 being gathered together for delivery when I visited this week (17th May).

Another project benefiting from the group is the hostel which helps vulnerable women as part of the Ipswich Prostitution Strategy. Quilts are being made to brighten the bedrooms.

The group hold occasional fund-raising events to raise money some of which is used to purchase fabric for the neo-natal quilts, whilst the remainder is donated to other charitable causes.

New members are welcome and if you've never tried patchwork before, never fear as there are beginners in the group as well as experienced patch-workers who can help you get started and a library of books to inspire and resolve technical questions.

Not only does the group have equipment such as irons and a binding machine for members' use, it also has a spare sewing machine which can be loaned for a trial session.

If you would like to try your hand at patchwork, please contact **Pat Ward on 01206 322253**. Free tea and coffee and a friendly welcome at every session are assured!

Should you have some cotton fabric languishing in your cupboard, the group would be delighted if you would like to donate it to them for the neo-natal guilts; please contact Pat or call in to a meeting.

The group meet at the Langham Community Centre on the 3rd Wednesday of each month between 10.00am and 3pm. The fee for each session is £3.00.

If you can't stay all day, you are welcome to go along for as long as you can spare.


