## LANGHAM EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM



The Langham Village Emergency Telephone System (VETS) is now up and running. If you are with a person who you suspect has had a cardiac arrest, immediately call 999 as normal.

An ambulance will be dispatched as soon as possible, however due to the location of Langham, this may take a while.

You will probably be alone with the patient and cannot leave them to go and get the village defibrillator, so we have a group of 10 volunteers who will respond to a telephone call from you.

All the volunteers are on the same number and if a volunteer is available you give them your location, they will collect the defibrillator and come to your location, they will then assist in CPR and using the defibrillator until the ambulance or medics arrive.

**Spotlight On...  
BOXTED METHODIST SILVER BAND**



The Band was formed in 1898 although there used to be a wind band at the chapel before that. The idea was to play 'to the honour and glory of God' and that is still at the head of our constitution. The Band has played continuously over the years although with fluctuations in numbers and is one of the last Methodist Bands in the country.

We play at the Chapel for special services such as Remembrance, Good Friday and Christmas, as well as a monthly Band Service which is organised by members of the Band on the first Sunday of the month apart from August, and to which anybody is welcome. Our September and December Band services are usually held at the Village Hall to be more accessible to the village. The Band plays a wide repertoire of music from brass band classics, marches, songs from stage and screen, jazz, and some arrangements of popular songs. We always end a rehearsal or concert with a hymn tune in some form and play Christmas carols around the village each year, trying to cover most of the houses in the village.

We play wherever asked - concerts, fetes, park bandstands and church services throughout the area, as well as supporting events in Boxted such as the Queen's Birthday last year. We have also had band 'away weekends' visiting other churches for a concert on the Saturday night and then playing for the service on the Sunday morning.

We play the traditional instruments found in a brass band from the small soprano cornet to the largest Bb bass. Our members range in age from 11 to 80s with roughly half each, male and female. We are currently looking for more cornet players otherwise we have a full band of twenty five players plus conductor.

**BOXTED HISTORY GROUP**

An illustrated talk entitled 'A Transport Revolution' was given to the group in March by the Treasurer, Sue Brown.

The Romans left England with a well-constructed network of roads which progressively deteriorated, until virtually unusable for the transportation of heavy materials required by the late 19<sup>th</sup> century to sustain the industrial revolution.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> Earl of Bridgewater owned extensive coal mines in the Manchester area but these were subject to severe flooding. He appointed engineer James Brindley to devise a system to de-water the mines using the latest technology – steam driven pumps. Brindley also constructed a long channel linking Manchester to the River Mersey mainly to dispose of the mine water, but which later became famous as the Bridgewater Canal.

The success of this canal as a means of transporting materials and finished goods led to Brindley constructing a network of canals known as the Grand Cross, which linked the rivers Severn, Mersey, Thames and Trent. Many others across the country were to follow.

Sue's talk covered in depth the design and construction of the canal system, the narrow boats used on them and the people who lived and worked the boats.

After W.W.2 the commercial use of the canals rapidly declined but of late there has been resurgence in their use for leisure purposes.

## RUBBISH & RECYCLING CHANGES

Changes to Colchester's rubbish and recycling collections will be introduced from June 2017 to help boost recycling and cut waste.

The collections changes include:

- Introducing fortnightly collections for general rubbish
- A maximum of three black sacks per household
- Food waste will continue to be collected weekly
- All other recycling collections are unchanged and residents should continue to use their existing recycling containers for paper, plastics, cans, glass, textiles, food and green waste
- Free clear sacks will be delivered but residents won't receive free black sacks
- White garden sacks will be free from June 2017
- A second free green box is available so glass and cans can be separated (available now).
- Will not include wheelie bins for our villages
