Boxted Airfield 75th Anniversary 1943 - 2018

The walk starts at the museum at 11:00 AM and covers a distance of approximately 2 and 1/2 miles over flat ground. During the walk we will be visiting the various buildings still extant on the airfield where your guide will talk about the use and history of the airfield and its buildings. The walk will be led by Richard Turner & John Dobrowski. John's father served as a P47 Thunderbolt engine Mechanic. NORTH EAST ESSEX BADGER GROUP

If you enjoy getting out in the countryside in your local area, have you considered getting involved with your local badger group?

The Group is a voluntary organisation whose aim is to protect badgers, their setts and habitats in North East Essex, working with other wildlife protection groups, statutory authorities, police and landowners.

We are involved in all aspects of badger protection; i.e. recording and surveying setts, rescuing and rehabilitating injured badgers, as well as orphaned cubs, and recovering dead badgers which have been involved in road accidents. Surveying land areas earmarked for future development is often carried out, as well as giving advice and assistance to landowners dealing with badger related problems.

We are made up of five individual sections covering Colchester (including Mount Bures/Bures), Tendring, Maldon, Halstead and Braintree. The Colchester section hold regular monthly meetings at the Cricketers Public House, Fordham Heath on the second Tuesday of every month. We are looking for new members covering your area – you will find a membership form on our website: www.neebg.co.uk or alternatively have a chat with Judy (Colchester section leader) on **07702** 489668.

You can become as involved as you like. Some people are happy just to support us and receive regular information. Others are able to be more active and, once familiarised with badger "data", have their own setts to look after and check, help with recovering dead badgers, or even go on to be able to handle injured live ones!
