Dear Friends,

In this first Newsletter of 2019 may I wish you a happy, healthy and peace-filled year. May it be one in which you conquer your challenges and keep your resolutions. I wonder whether any of you have made a resolution to come to church more frequently, or to get to know God better, if so, please let me know and say if I can do anything to help you.

As well as looking forward I'd like to look back a little as well, because I'd like to thank you for your very warm welcome on my return from my Sabbatical. We had an amazing time, visiting Singapore, Thailand, Laos, Vietnam, Cambodia: Perth, Adelaide, Melbourne, Brisbane and Sydney in Australia and finally Hong Kong. It is impossible to summarise all that we did which included learning to cook in people's homes, going on 20 different boats and a dozen rivers, seeing more temples than can be remembered, hearing the Buddhist Monks chanting at 4.30 in the morning, learning to cross the road in Saigon and Hanoi very slowly, so that the 40/50 scooters to every car, can drive round you, visiting impoverished hill villages in Laos, learning about different wines in the respective areas of Australia, making new friends and visiting old friends and family, and much more. We were very fortunate.

Sadly, I developed severe sciatica whilst we were away and we had to return early. Since then I have had a spinal injection which helped for a while, but is wearing off. I am therefore having spinal surgery on 6th February. I regret that I will be on Sick Leave for six weeks afterwards, but will back in good time to celebrate Easter.

COMMUNITY FIRST RESPONDERS.

CARING, COMPASSIONATE AND THERE FOR YOU

CFR's are trained volunteers who are dispatched by the ambulance service to life threatening emergencies in local

communities.

The volunteers normally work within a radius of 8 minutes drive from their location but depending on circumstances this could be further afield. They can normally get to a casualty before an ambulance can get there, assess the patient and start possible life saving treatment immediately. If the situation changes the CFR can update Ambulance Control to give them an updated assessment of the patient.

The Local area is covered by a CFR bag located in Langham (the bag was supplied by Stratford St Mary Parish Council) and also other bags in Dedham, East Bergholt, Caple St Mary and Manningtree.

The bag is presently used by only one volunteer in Langham.

A volunteer can be on call when ever they want, if you are logged off duty, you do not get called.

At the moment the Stratford St Mary bag is not utilised as much as it could be and I would like to improve this. Ideally I would like some volunteers in the Langham, Stratford St Mary, Boxted and Dedham areas to complete the training and then join me in covering our area. The more hours we have the bag active the better cover we have for ourselves.





BOXTED HISTORY GROUP

The subject of the illustrated talk at Novembers meeting was the building of the tower at Bury St Edmunds Cathedral. The Clerk of Works for the project, "Horry Parson", traced the history of the original abbey to its extension in the 1960's. As so often happens due to financial restraints the tower did not progress above roof level and was later resurrected by the Millennium project, this was not the end of the challenges seem but in part due to Prince Charles the tower was completed and is largely what was planned 50 years ago.

In contrast the last meeting of 2018 was a very colourful "Eccentric look at East Anglia's Countryside" by local historian author and radio presenter "Charles Haylock" relating to the social history and restraints imposed on the residents of the area from the 'Landed Gentry to the Peasants'.


