Langham 10K & 2K Race

We need your help!



Unfortunately due to a lack of volunteers willing to help organise and run this event, there is a threat it may not continue from this year.

This event is an incredibly popular race for runners and is a fantastic community event as well as an imperative fundraiser for Langham Primary School.

In recent years the school has been able to refurbish the children's toilets as well as provide the magnificent shipwreck play equipment, fund school trips/extra curricular workshops and with cuts in School Government funding the loss of this event would be significant.

The 10k & 2k fun run has been running for over 15 years. We need volunteers who are willing to take on some small part of the organisation of the event. This could involve obtaining quotes for and organising services for the day; arranging sponsorship; helping manage the website and social media posts. We also need volunteers to give up a few hours on the morning of Sunday 8th September to help run the event on the day. This could involve being a marshall on the course; helping with issuing race numbers as competitors arrive; helping with refreshments; helping to set up for the day and clearing up after everyone has gone home.

This is an event run by parents of the school but due to the size of the event now, we need to reach out to community volunteers also.

St. Peter's Tower Repairs

St. Peter's Church tower has been leaking for some years and the Diocesan Architect has now advised that repairs are needed urgently to prevent long-term damage to the tower. Parts of the tower masonry are also badly in need of repair and repointing. The PCC's plan is to do the masonry work at the same time as the scaffolding is up for the tower roof repairs. Assuming that sufficient funds are in place we are looking to start the work in September this year.

St. Peter's, which is a Grade I Listed Building, is not only a most lovely Norman church, but almost certainly the oldest and most notable building in Boxted. St. Peter's is available for baptisms, weddings and funerals and is left open for visitors everyday.

Our architects have prepared a full specification for the works, upon this basis, the total funds we need for the repair works and the related professional fees are £61,500 +VAT. The VAT element should be recoverable from a government fund available for repairs to Grade I listed buildings.

After a period of worrying deterioration, which reduced our reserves, the PCC considers the prudent course is to retain its remaining reserves as a buffer against future financial uncertainties. We propose to raise the necessary funds through a combination of donations, grants and fundraising events. Applications for grants are under way. Most grants are offered upon the basis that other fundraising will contribute at least 50% of the total funding required. We are also finalising a programme of fundraising events which will take place during this current calendar year.

BOXTED HISTORY GROUP

A well illustrated talk on the "Angel Roofs of East Anglian Churches" by Michael Rimmer opened the groups 2019 programme. Between 1395 and 1534 the country in general and East Anglia in particular experienced a period of great wealth which fuelled a surge in the construction of large highly decorated churches. Many had impressive hammer beam roof structures incorporating life size carved wooden effigies of angels and saints, which were constructed in "offsite" workshops, dismantled and transported to site—600 years before IKEA! Following the Reformation of 1640 religious imagery was systematically destroyed or defaced but by and large the Angel roofs escaped, believed to be due to them being high up and difficult to reach. Today 83% of all remaining Angel roofs are located in East Anglia.
