"I don't know what we would do without you."

Over the past 10 years, Good Neighbours volunteers have undertaken some **1,000 small acts of service** to the elderly or disabled folk of Boxted and Langham. All of them speak of the gratitude expressed by people they have helped.

We started in 2009 with 49 Volunteers but age and other factors have now reduced the number to 30. Of these 30, many are in their seventies and some are even older. The appeals for help are undiminished but new volunteers have not come forward in the numbers needed to ensure the Good Neighbours continue long into the future. Our current band of volunteers will not be able to deal with the growing demand for help for many more years.

Boxted History Group

Occasionally the group has had a talk by a local speaker but this month fellow member John Carter told the story of Charles Cruft the famous Dog Show promoter.

Born in Bloomsbury in 1852 Cruft left school at 14 to work in a local shop making and selling what would become Spratts Dog Biscuits.

Within 2 years he had reorganised the running of the shop, increased sales at home and introduced Spratts products to European Dog Owners.

Whilst in Paris he was invited to organised a dog show and its success led him to build a business organising shows

internationally. At the time owning a dog was expensive consequently his shows were supported by the rich and famous including Royalty, but by the time of his death in 1978 the London show alone attracted over 10,000 entries from all breeds.

Ironically Cruft was a cat lover who never owned a dog and his 2 attempts to organise a cat shown were financial disasters.
