JEREMY CARTER 1930—2017

Jeremy was born & grew up at Hill Farm, Boxted & early on became involved in village life, organising gymkhanas, junior cricket matches & other events.

Jeremy did his national service in the Army, fought in the Korean War & then became a regular. He met his future wife, Mary in Hong Kong & together they enjoyed over 60 years of happy marriage.

Jeremy rose to the rank of Colonel, finishing his army career in Prague as Defence Attache in the British Embassy.

Having taken early retirement he came home to serve Boxted. He became Chairman of the Parish Council & got the village website off the ground, Chairman of the British Legion, served on the Parochial Church Council & the Stour Valley Trust.

In the last few years Jeremy had not been well and was eventually diagnosed with Lewy Body Dementia & died peacefully at Woodland View Care Home aged 87.

HERITAGE GROUP LANGHAM 22 NOVEMBER

On Wednesday 22 November at 7.30 pm there will be a meeting at Langham Community Centre to consider the formation of a "heritage" group in Langham with the objectives of acquiring and preserving material relating to the history of the village and of encouraging and developing interest in that history.

BOXTED HISTORY GROUP

At the August meeting Charlotte Harding stepped back in time to trace the history of Warner's Silk Mill in Braintree.

Warner's originated in East London and, having expanded to Braintree in 1822 and widening their range of products to include high quality dress materials, they produced material for many Royal wedding dresses, as well as all the fabrics used to decorate Westminster Abbey for the Queen's coronation.

A decline in demand and competition from imports led to the closure of the company, but as several of the original hand operated looms were acquired by Richard Humphreys they are once again producing fine fabrics for use in stately homes and palaces, but now in Sudbury.

Examples of the various types of fabrics and the techniques used to produce them can be seen in a museum just opposite Braintree bus station.



The second visit in the groups summer programme was to the Mayflower Project in Harwich. The original aim of the project was to build a full size replica of the Mayflower and sail it to North America in 2020 to celebrate the 400th anniversary of the Pilgrim Fathers crossing.

However although construction of the ship has begun, difficulty in raising the necessary capital has slowed the project to the point where the original aim has been amended to establishing a heritage centre with the replica of the Mayflower being the main attraction.
