### Parish Churches Update from the PCC

I am sure you will want to wish Rev. Mandy Elmes an enjoyable and productive period of study leave. She and her husband Paul, who recently retired from his dental practice, set off on their travels last month and are expected to return on 4th December.

Meanwhile, the work of the church in our joint Parish of Langham with Boxted will continue as normal. Visiting clergy from neighbouring parishes will lead Sunday morning services at the usual times while Anne Mason from St. Luke's Highwoods will lead our fortnightly Bible studies and Jo Jeffries, our youth and families worker, will visit our local schools in Rev. Mandy's place. Meanwhile, our two church wardens and the PCC will be keeping everything running smoothly.

Members of the congregation are also actively involved in leading a number of ventures in our two villages. There is our Good Neighbours Scheme for giving lifts to the housebound, our Open Door cafe in Boxted village hall on Friday mornings during term time and our youth groups which meet in Boxted Methodist Hall. The church also has an involvement in Boxted school through the Open the Book programme which presents Bible stories during worship times as well as regular visits from the foundation governor. Recently, members of the congregation contributed towards the creation of St. Peter's garden in the school grounds. This space for peace and reflection was opened by Bishop Roger in July.

## LANGHAM LADIES

Last month, Ruth Millar gave us a fascinating insight into the history of the Foundling Hospital, founded in the 18th Century by Thomas Coram, supported by the aristocracy as well as artists such as William Hogarth, Gainsborough and Reynolds. Handel was also a great supporter of the Hospital which produced many good musicians, some of who were recruited into the bands of the armed forces.

Her recollections of her early life as a Coram foundling, spent first with foster parents followed by an education at the hospitals Berkhamsted school as a border until the age of 15, were moving and thought provoking, bearing in mind this was the 20th Century. The charity continues today supporting children in difficulty who need foster parents and Ruth is now a governor of the charity and one of the very few foundlings remaining.

Our meeting next month, 11th October is a talk by Barbara McElory about Ernest Hemmingway.

We are also taking names for the Christmas shopping trip to Downton & Boundary Mills on the A1 near Grantham on Wednesday 28th November which is open to both members and guests.
