BOXTED HISTORY GROUP

The history of chocolate was the subject of our July talk, with some interesting facts including how manufactures Frys and Cadburys gave Queen Victoria two pounds of chocolate every day to help promote their products.

In August the second of this years visits was to Otley Hall in Suffolk. It is known that there has been a moated property on the site from as early as 1190 but being of wooden construction have disappeared long ago. The origins of the present property dates from the 15th century and has been extended and altered over time by numerous owners. What we see now is affine Grade I Listed building which is recognised as one of the top 20 historic houses in the U.K. Blessed with fine weather and complete with tea and cakes it was a memorable afternoon.


