Boxted Parish Council Report – August 2020

big thank-you to the Langham and Boxted Newsletter editor for inviting Boxted Parish Council to include a report.

Boxted's Council meets 10 times a year on the 2nd Wednesday of each month except for August and December. When lock-down started the Council suspended all physical meetings but legislation was soon passed allowing virtual council meetings and now our Councillors have become regular users of zoom.

Members of the public are very much welcome to join us on these meetings. There is a regular slot at

the start of each meeting for people to raise any issues which, if they can't be answered straight away, then the Council can take them away and respond afterwards. The minutes of each meeting are published on the new Parish Council website (**boxtedparishcouncil.org.uk**).

Most Council business is routine, but this year has been anything but routine.

Firstly, the Council had to close the play area and skate park – signage, locks and cable ties were in place to deter people from



using the equipment - but some continued to use it. Fortunately, we have been allowed to open the areas now, but people should note that the equipment is not cleaned, and people should wash/sanitise hands frequently and maintain social distancing.

The Hub café closed its doors and quickly morphed to a "meals on wheels" service helping those people shielding in the village. The Hub, along with some volunteers ran a support service (shopping, prescriptions etc) for shielding or isolating residents, and Boxted Council the supported Good Neighbours Scheme that stepped up to help both Boxted and Langham villages.

We haven't seen any football or cricket matches since March, but practice and matches are starting again on the playing field. The changing facilities aren't available, and the Hub café is still closed to the public – although orders for food etc can be phoned through.

Whilst the Hub café was closed, we were able to get the building render improved.

We were able to plant several small whips (tree stems) around the field but the hot weather has not been good for them. Volunteers have helped water and weed around these areas. A big thankyou to the volunteers. outine business has included health and safety equipment checks, the annual tree survey assessing the health and status of all the trees on the playing field, passing comment on planning applications in Boxted, getting the playing field grass cut and repairing part of the signpost at Boxted Cross.

The Council also has a role in acting as Trustee for the Village Hall and this year have managed to secure a grant for stage lighting for the Boxted Players (still to be ordered) and we have new fire-retardant curtains going in. There are four newly installed bike racks on the front wall and it would be great to see these used – remember to bring your own chain.

t Helena Hospice's Midnight Walk returns in September – with a twist – it's been relaunched as a virtual day time event, renamed as the Midday Walk for 2020.



Sarah Wilson, St Helena Hospice's fundraising manager, said: "A virtual Midday Walk isn't quite how we envisioned our biggest event of the year; but

we're making the best of this new virtual world we're living in, whilst encouraging people to support their local hospice and stay active.

"Where we normally would all walk 4.5 or 9 miles together around Colchester; we're now asking people to walk either on their own, or with their households – and they can choose whatever location they want – it could be their garden, their stairs, the treadmill, the park or the beach!"
